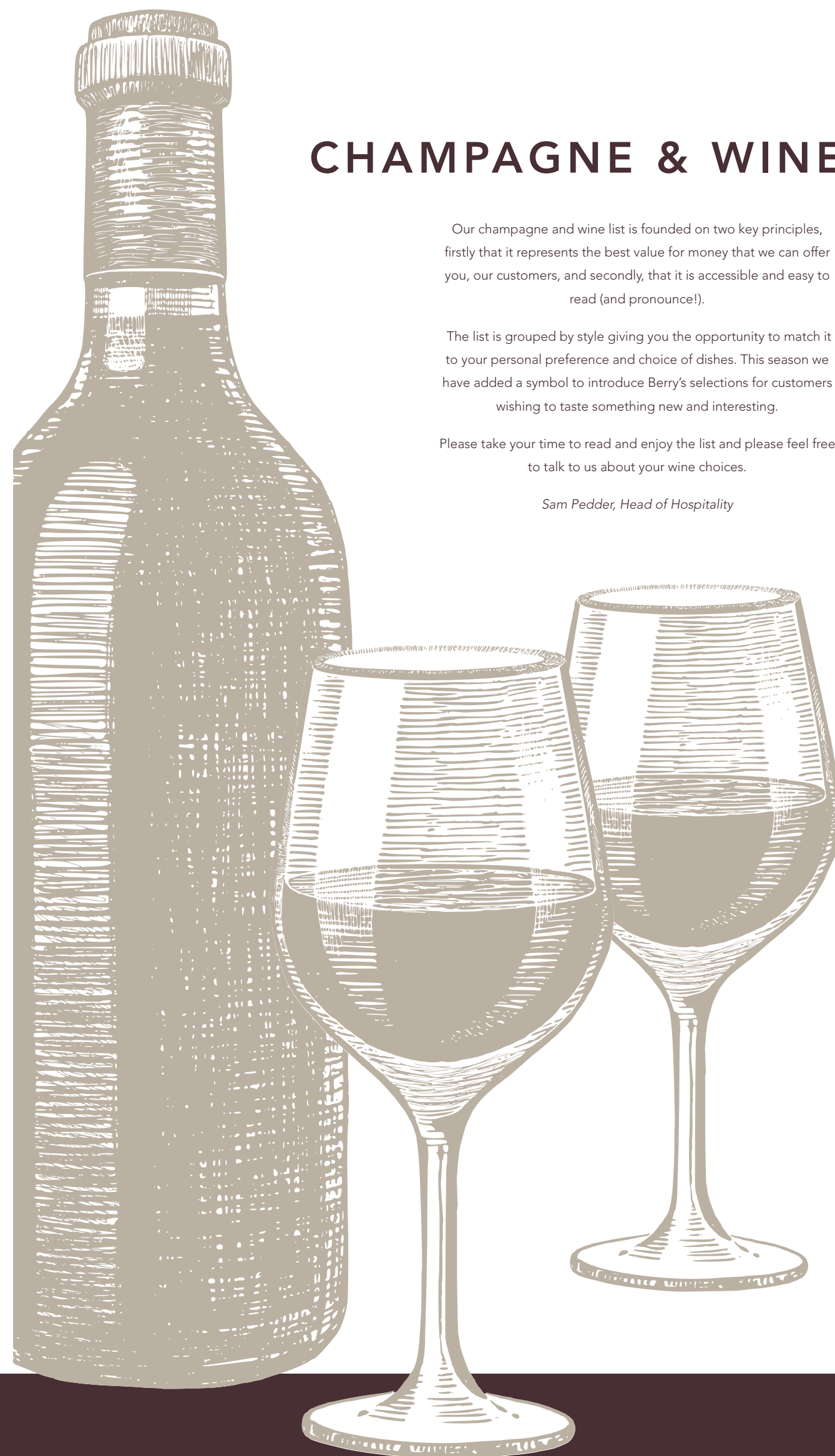
## CHAMPAGNE & WINE LIST
