- Berry Bros. & Rudd can trace its origins back to 1698 when the Widow Bourne founded her shop opposite St James's Palace. Having traded from the same premises at 3 St James's Street for over 300 years, Berrys is the oldest wine and spirit merchant in Britain and possibly the world.
- Berry Bros. & Rudd is still family – owned and run. Today the present generations of Berrys and Rudds continue to manage the family – owned wine merchant business. The youngest members represent the eighth generation. Traditional values of service and quality are upheld and co-exist with modern business practices.
- Berrys source wines of character and quality often in small parcels from small producers from both the southern and northern hemispheres. 'Good Ordinary Claret' is the best-selling wine and is part of the range of over 70 own-label products.
